\$100,000 Matching Challenge

We have been challenged by three of our faithful families to help raise \$200,000 for our Capital Campaign. Every dollar offered will be matched! Please make checks out to AMGOC with the word CHALLENGE in the memo.

At our General Assembly on Sunday December 14, 2025 the community voted to move forward with making an offer on the proposed property. The seller of the 4925 List Dr. has selected our church and issued a counteroffer. We responded with a full-price offer that includes concessions for property improvements, most notably the removal of the large refrigeration equipment. Additionally, two families have pledged a \$50,000 matching-grant challenge. The capital campaign fundraising goal for the renovation project is \$350,000.
